
# NSS/NGO Collaboration Proposal

#### **About CollCom**

CollCom is a College-Community network, a JNU NSS alumni driven non-profitable registered organization, established to give training, and mentoring to the NSS Volunteers, strengthen the National Service Scheme (NSS) units, Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan Clubs, and other youth led organizations in colleges/Schools across the country. It provides a platform to college/school students to work closely with community or villages to understand their problems and needs, and involve themselves in the problem-solving process, so that life of these people or villagers can be raised at higher material and moral level.

Since the inception (5 Sept 2018) of organization, the organization worked with NSS units of premium institute of our country such as Jawaharlal Nehru University, Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University, Netaji Subash University of Technology (NSUT), Delhi University (such as Deen Dayal Upadhyaya College, Janki Devi Memorial College, Indraprastha College for Women, Hindu College, Sri Venkateshwara College), NSS Office, Mission Shakti Project of UP Government, and many more. We have conducted 18 shorts and long duration Internship programs, conducted than 250 more workshops/webinars/seminars, 5 Special Camps, mentored more than 4500 NSS volunteers, and numbers are increasing gradually.

## Purpose of the Collaboration

Due to very vast and broad defined activities of National Service Scheme (NSS), lack of understanding of the purpose of community engagement activities, lack of guidance and framework of understanding social problems, unaware of the process of adopting rural village for social welfare activities, lack of understanding of scientific methods of doing field survey to develop the depth understanding on the real-life problems, difficulty in planning and organising 7/10 Days Village Special Camp, impact assessment of events and campaigns,

ack of mentoring and administrative supports from NSS state and regional office, struggle to complete the minimum requirements to earn 240 hours NSS Award Certificate at the end of 2 years of NSS Volunteering and many more, these are the some of the challenges observed. There is a need of an expert organizations who can help these things to be executed smoothly in achieving the goal of students engaged in NSS. CollCom has been established by NSS Alumni to full-fill this gap.

## **Objectives of the collaboration**

Mentoring NSS volunteers to conduct a field survey in a scientific way to understand the social problems, guiding NSS Volunteers to design, develop, and implement a sustainable solution, measuring the Impact of social events and campaigns, and publishing the important findings in national media, national/international conferences/journals, will develop confidence and personality of NSS volunteers. It will also help college to get good NAAC/NIRF ranking.

All these activities will help students to develop a sense of civic responsibilities, and able to complete the minimum requirements of 240 hours to earn prestigious NSS Certificate.

## **Proposed Activities**

There is already defined list of annual proposed activities for NSS by the head office of NSS, Government of India which is available on the nss government website. Entire activities are categorised into four categories – Education, Health, Environment and Skilling /Entrepreneurship. We have simplified it further and the list of proposed annual activities but not limited is attached for your reference. With the need and demand, some more activities can be added or modified.

#### As an NGO, we will offer

- ·Internship or different volunteering opportunities to the NSS Volunteers to plan the individual as well as joint events/campaigns/activities in a scientific way so that its impact can be measured
- Mentoring to NSS Volunteers in conducting field survey, doing research on social problems
- ·Assisting volunteers to document the findings of research problems for publication wherever needed
- Provide the necessary supports of experts panel to execute the campaign successfully.

All creatives/posters/videos of joint campaigns/events can be jointly shared on NSS official page of college/WhatsApp as well as CollCom organization's social media handles/WhatsApp.

#### **Resources Required**

In terms of resources, we only expect a college's auditorium, or seminar hall or meeting room or ground is required for holding meetings or events. There is no financial expectation for collaboration.

#### **Evaluation Plan**

Success of collaboration will be evaluated based on number of creatives/posters/videos published on social media, number of online and offline events organized jointly, and outcome of findings in terms of publication in national media/conferences/journals. The successful completion of tenure of NSS Volunteers, Internship Completion Certificate will be awarded with number of hours and top volunteers will be awarded with Gifts and Best Volunteers Award /Rising Leader Award.

## Conclusion

The founder of CollCom is having 11 odd years of experience of working in/with NSS. Based on his extensive experience and dedication of working with NSS and demand of the time, he established the concept of mentoring NSS Volunteers. This collaboration will help NSS Volunteers to work on a real -life problems, understanding the problems in a scientific way, working on designing and building sustainable solutions. The exposure of guided community service will assist students to discover their inner strength and potentials, create depth understanding on the real-life problems. Dr Gaurav is currently working as an Assistant Professor in the School of Computer Engineering and Technology at Bennett University (Times Group), Greater Noida. He is also NSS Program Coordinator of Bennett University, and Founder and Director of a Non Profitable Social Venture CollCom. He is having more than three years of work experience and published 9 Research Papers in International Journals and Conferences. His research areas are Sentiment Analysis, Recommendation System, Multi Criteria Decision Support System, Machine Learning and Field Study on Internet Crime. Currently he is working on Building ML models through a designed Questionnaire cum Training on understanding the knowledge of users of our country about Internet Crime, understanding the growing rate of Internet Crime and Victim. His last working institution was GLA University Mathura where he served 1.5 years.

Dr Kumar believes in Learning by Doing pedagogy of doing study and research. For this, he has established a social venture named CollCom (College Community Social Venture), which aims to **empower Schools and College Youth through community service**. Dr Kumar has completed his **M.Tech and PhD in Computer Science from one of the prestigious institutes of our country named Jawaharlal Nehru University**, New Delhi. During his education, he was active in community engagement field activities such as Teaching children in the Slum Basti, Waste Management, Tree Plantation, Health, Yoga and Fitness Awareness, Internet Crime awareness and many more. He has also received **Gold Medal Award from the University** and the **Best Volunteer Award from the Ministry of Human Resource Development**, Govt of India, for making tremendous efforts in creating awareness.

After completing his PhD, He opened a Food Cloud Kitchen Startup (Swaaduasti Food) to promote healthy food and create employment opportunities to fulfil the dream of our Honorable Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi Ji. But due to some technical failure, the startup was closed in 6 months of operations just before Covid started. He did not lose hope. During the Covid time, Dr Kumar did not sit ideally. He started working on helping people with plasma and oxygen support. Everyone was becoming dependent on the Internet for doing day-to-day work. Soon, he realized the importance of the lack of awareness of Cyber Crime.

He launched a Mega Campaign on Cyber Crime Awareness. He started visiting different schools and colleges (offline and online) and **delivered more than 35 Workshops on Cyber Crime Awareness**. He developed a short and very innovative Online Self Guide Cyber Crime Awareness Training Module in which **more than 52,000 people from across the country participated and benefitted**. He aims to **empower 10 Lakh people** of our country in the next two years.
